Cal/OSHA's Wildfire Smoke Regulation: What Employers Need to Know

On July 30, 2019, Cal/OSHA announced that they had enacted the emergency wildfire regulations to protect workers from hazards associated with wildfire smoke. This was in response to the severe wildfire seasons that we had in 2017 and 2018. The emergency regulations were set to expire on January 28, 2020 but have been renewed and are still in effect.

It is important to remember when considering if this may be a regulation that you need to learn more about, that smoke from wildfires can travel hundreds of miles. This means that though a company might not face physical danger from a wildfire in its general area, the smoke from the fire that reaches them can be thick and dangerous, reaching unhealthy levels. That smoke can pose a risk to the safety and health of their employees.

We are again nearing fire season coming out of what some weather scientist have said has been the driest February on record while expecting this to be one of the hottest summers we have had.
