Cal/OSHA COVID-19 Prevention Program Review

On November 30, 2020 California's Office of Administrative Law approved a Temporary Emergency Regulation enforceable by Cal/OSHA for a COVID-19 Protection Program. With some exceptions, all employers and places of employment are required to establish and implement an effective written COVID-19 Prevention Program (CPP) pursuant to recently approved Emergency Temporary Standard for COVID-19 which can now be found in the California Code of Regulations (CCR), Title 8, section 3205(c). Cal/OSHA has developed a model program to assist employers with creating their own unique CPP tailored to their workplace. Join us for the webinar as Mr. Dan Leiner, Area Manager, Cal/OSHA Consultation guides us on what employers need to know to develop their written program.
